MALBEC 2010 Origin: Mendoza, Argentina Varietal: Malbec 100% Vintage: 2010 Vineyards: Maipú Yield per hectare: 8,000 kilograms. Alcohol content: 12.9% Serving temperature: 64 F°

PRODUCTION: Fermentation carried out in concrete vats, using selected yeasts at temperatures of 64-77 F°. Three homogenization daily stirs, the skins in touch with oak providing great depth of color and fruity aromas.

AGING: Aged for 8 months in American and French oak barrels prior to bottling, acquiring the typical oak notes and a great bouquet.

TASTING NOTES: Intense, plum red color, with violet hues, young and with great visual body. Fresh picked raspberry aromas along with plums and other red berries. Notorious for being a vigorous yet delicate wine with fruity structure and subtle aromas of coffee and vanilla as well as smoky hints due to its contact with the oak. Offers the palate it shows soft, velvety plum and raspberry flavors as well as some mulberry, achieving a perfect balance with the tannins provided by the wood.
